**General rules and health requirements for CT Dairy Cattle Shows apply.
Parents and exhibitors, please read these rules thoroughly.**

General Rules:

1. The minimum age for Junior Dairy Exhibitors will be **9** years of age and maximum of **19** years of age as of the day of show.
2. All animals must have proof of Rabies vaccination at least 30 days prior to start of fair to be shown at CT fairs and shows, a certificate of health must accompany each animal.
3. A copy of Health papers must accompany each entry.
4. The Committee reserves the right to reject any entry in question and to remove any animal from the grounds for health reasons.
5. All animals entered in an exhibitors name must be owned or leased by that person and shown by that person. Registration and typewritten lease papers will be inspected before showing on Saturday.
6. Make out entries using Entry form provided. Please print clearly and specify classes by numbers.
7. It is important that the number of animals (LIMIT 5 ANIMALS PER FARM/FAMILY/CLUB) be specified on the entry as well as the breed, this is necessary so the proper number of ties can be reserved. Entries are limited to the first 25 cattle entered.
8. All animals must be on the grounds NO LATER than 2:00 p.m. on Friday.
9. Transportation fee will be reimbursed at \$50.00 per farm.
10. All livestock must remain on grounds until 6:00 p.m. Sunday.
11. Exhibitors are asked to rake all bedding and uneaten hay towards center of tent after their animals are removed on Sunday for cleanup.
12. Bedding will be furnished by the fair in an appropriate quantity: 1 bale straw/day/animal.
13. Exhibitor for his/her own animals must supply hay and grain.
14. Exhibitors are responsible for upkeep of their area and animals. Animals must be double-tied.
15. Judging will begin at 10:00 a.m. Saturday with the Showmanship Class. Judge decision is FINAL.
16. Show whites are required. Showmanship classes may be altered or combined as necessary.
17. Breed classes will follow as soon as possible after showmanship on Saturday.
18. Any Exhibitor dispensing or consuming any alcoholic beverages in the show tent will forfeit their premium monies.
19. Exhibitors must be present to show animals.
20. Due to space restrictions, only instate entries will be accepted. Entries must be postmarked on or after August 1st. Entries postmarked prior to August 1st will be returned. Space will be reserved as entries are received. A copy of health papers must accompany entries in order for entries to be accepted. Include a copy of typewritten lease papers for any animals not registered in exhibitor's name.
