CLASS U – JUNIOR SHEEP

General Rules:

- Non-refundable entry fees should accompany entry blank and are \$1.00 per animal. Make check
 payable to Wolcott Country Fair. Entry deadline is August 1st.
- 2. Exhibitors are limited to not more than two breeds and may have no more than two entries per class (one entry per class group). One market lamb per entry.
- 3. All sheep must be accompanied by an official health certificate issued by the Connecticut Department of Agriculture during the current year and proof of rabies vaccination for flock at least 30 days prior to show. Any animal not vaccinated for rabies will not be allowed to be exhibited. Send a copy of Certificate with entry, showing Scrapie Program Farm Number, if any.
- 4. Entries closed as soon as pens are full. Pens are full at 50 sheep.
- 5. Exhibitor must furnish grain and hay, straw bedding will be provided.
- 6. Certificate of breed registration must accompany each animal and be made available to the Superintendent prior to judging.
- 7. All recognized, registered breeds will be shown together for each class. Classes will be judged and premiums awarded only if there are at least two entries per class.
- 8. Youth entries must be marked as such with the age of the exhibitor.
- 9. Exhibitors are responsible to keep aisles clean and clear. Blankets should be kept off animals from 10:00AM Saturday to release time on Sunday.
- 10. Owner or shepherd must be present during the time of judging.
- Animals will be accepted on fairgrounds from 3:00PM-9:00PM on Friday, 7:00AM-9:00AM on Saturday, and remain on the fairgrounds until release time. Release time will be up to the discretion of the Superintendent.
- 12. Fleece Contest Scored on: 1) Cleanliness; 2) Luster; and 3) Staple. Only 2 fleece per entry.
- **13.** Show order will be as appears in this book and alphabetically by breed. Market lambs are last.
- 14. Lead line contest will be held at 3:00PM on Saturday. Contestants must show interest in sheep and be between the ages of 12 and under for Junior Class, and 13-20 (as of January 1st) for the Senior Class. Entrants must have 50% of the garments made of 100% wool. Garments should be appropriate, attractive, and add elegance to the class. The sheep must be over 6 months of age, conditioned, fitted and trained to show in halter. No coloring of animals is allowed. Sheep should be presented in the most attractive manner possible. The youth and the sheep should enhance each other. An entry form, in story form, should be submitted to the Superintendent at least 10 days prior to the show. The entry should contain the contestant's name, address, age, school attending, hobbies, and a brief biography of the garment the contestant is wearing.

Scoring:

Poise and Appearance of Contestant	25 points
Garment	25 points
Control and Presentation of Sheep	25 points
Appearance of Sheep	25 points
Bonus Points if Garment is Handmade	5 points
Bonus Points of Story written by Contestant	5 points

- **15**. Decision of the judge is final. Where there is no competition, premiums will be up to the judge's discretion.
- 16. Potluck supper will be held on Saturday night in the sheep tent. Bring a dish.
- 17. Sheep premiums are subject to change.
- **18**. All interpretation of the Rules of the Sheep Show is at the discretion of the Wolcott Lions Animal Superintendents.
